



Practice Fees from 1st November 2023.

Fees are expected to be paid in full at the end of your consultation.

Level B consultation which is the standard appointment is ***\$93-\$97***

Other fees depend on the complexity and time taken for your consultation:

Level C consultation (for approx. 20-40 minutes) is ***\$155-\$160***

Level D consultation (greater than 40 minutes) is ***\$237-\$250***

All patients except children under 6 years, will be charged a private fee. This includes all Pension Card holders, Health Care Card holders and Commonwealth Seniors Health Care holders.

Pension Card holders may be charged a discounted fee of ***\$72-75*** for a standard appointment.

Telephone scripts are charged at ***\$25***

Other non-visit paperwork is charged at ***\$30***

Surgical procedures will attract a further fee dependent on complexity.

A treatment room fee of ***\$35*** or ***\$64*** (depending on complexity) will apply to procedures for example: complex dressings, application of a plaster, suturing of lacerations and IV fluid replacement. **The treatment room fee is non-refundable.**

A fee of ***\$38*** (inc GST) for a single appointment and ***\$78*** (inc GST) for a double appointment is charged if you do not attend an appointment or cancel without reasonable notification close to the appointment time.

Please note that a minimum fee of ***\$250*** is charged for out of hours call outs (Medicare rebate of \$142.20).

Emergency treatment is also available at the Bunbury Regional Hospital Emergency Department.

If appropriate, discounted fees for appointments can be given. Please discuss this with your GP at the time of your appointment.

The Federal Government determines the rebate you will receive from Medicare and every attempt has been made to keep Gap payments as low as possible.
